The Archery Season begins on the first Saturday in October which is October 1st this year and the firearms Season ends on the first Saturday in January which is January 7th, 06. I have been able to re-establish myself as a dealer for the E.A.R.custom molded ear plugs. These are the best, most comfortable ear plugs I have ever found, plus the sound protection can be up to 33 NRR. I am currently using a set I made for high power shooting 20 years ago, so I know they last a long time. Enough people expressed an interest, so I ordered the supplies, and have them on hand. I can make your custom molded ear plugs with carrying case for \$25. The process takes about 20-25 minutes, and requires that you not talk or move your jaw for about 15 minutes as the material sets up. The plugs are useable the next day. Relay 5: 1500 – 1630

Preference for relays 1-5 will be honored with pre registration and payment of entry fees until 30 minutes prior to stage 1.

Rules: In accordance with the current Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) rules, 9th edition:

John Garand Match: As issued M-1 Garand, M1941 Johnson Rifle, M-1 Carbine;

Springfield/Vintage Rifle Match: As issued 1903 Springfield Series, Model 1917, U. S. Krag.

Foreign Military Rifle: As issued by the Armed forces of a country other than the U. S. Semi-automatic or automatic rifles are not permitted.

AWARDS: Each participant will qualify to purchase an M1 Garand from the CMP. Application packets for the purchase of a standard M1 Garand will be available at the match. Medals for aggregate scores will be awarded in each category for 1st (6 entries), 2nd (12 entries), and 3rd (18 entries) places.

COURSE OF FIRE: Entry fee includes 30-06 M2 Ball ammunition or 30 Caliber M-1 Carbine ammunition.

Stage 1: 20 shots, prone, 20 minutes

Stage 2: 10 shots, standing to prone, 70 seconds;

Stage 3: 10 shots, standing to sitting or kneeling, 60 seconds

Stage 4: 10 shots, standing, 10 minutes;

FIVE SIGHTERS WILL ALLOWED BEFORE STAGE 1.

Three minutes prep time will be provided for each stage. Fifteen minutes between stages 2 and 3 are required for scoring and target change.

SCORING: All scoring will be by the competitors.

Shotgun Report:

Our shotgunners made strong finishes in the 2005 shooting season. Our proudest proud is team member **Jason Falbe**, who ran his first 100 straight at the right time in the right place – the Virginia State Skeet Championships! He won the 12 ga. class C trophy, and finished strong in the shoot off for high gun, going a full box of shells miss and out in doubles at stations 3,4,5 against the best shooters in Virginia. **Bob King** won .410-D with a fine 92, which included his second 25 straight with the little gun. **Phil Bushong** claimed a 5th place medal in 20 ga. D. The team effort was rounded out by **Jon Yagla**'s 95 in doubles and a nice pair of 98's in 12 and 20 ga.

Our trapshooting has continued to make good progress: big honors at the Maryland State match by **Frank Baker**, and **Jeff Jones** and Jon Yagla at the Virginia State match, and a runner-up performance by Yagla at 24-25 yds at the Iowa State match (900+ shooters), are the highlights of the trap season.

The new seasons start in September for trap and October for skeet. We are a solid club and produce shooters capable of competing at the highest levels. Its fun to break targets, and the more you break the better it gets. If you want to learn to shoot come on out an try 'em. Shooting is very proportional: the more you work at it the better you get.

Archery News:

The biggest change to deer hunting regulations this year is the use of crossbows. Crossbow hunting has it's own separate license this year, yet falls within the same season dates as the regular archery season. You will need to purchase this license if you intend to hunt with a crossbow during the archery or blackpowder seasons. You no longer are required to have a doctor's authorization; anyone can apply for a crossbow license this year. If you intend to hunt with both a bow and a crossbow, you must purchase both licenses. If you only intend to hunt with the crossbow then you would only be required to purchase the crossbow license and not need to purchase the regular bow license. If you have any questions, visit the VA State website: http://www.dgif.virginia.gov/index.asp for more information.

As a safety precaution when hunting with a crossbow, do not walk around with it cocked and loaded with a bolt (crossbow term for arrow). When walking, you can have cable cocked, but keep the bolt in a protected quiver until you are in your stand or blind. This should apply wherever you may hunt and not just on the club property.

As a note, Crossbows are not allowed for use on the archery range excelsior bales. You will be allowed to bring your own stand-alone crossbow target to shoot at on the archery range provided that broadheads are not used.
