Notes from the President:

The Roughrider Sporting Clays match was very close, going down to the very last target. Todd Hunter couldn't break his final pair, consisting of a bumble bee nested under a regular dome target. The bumble flew into woods with only a few nicks on it. Jon Yagla crushed his last pair, which were on the duck tower field, to claim the trophy. Melissa Botelho scared the wits out of all the men when she ran the opening 3 sets of pintails, but couldn't keep it together over the long program.
