Annual Wrap-Up: Our last official work party for 2011 was Nov – we had a good turn out and finished the fence on the action range. Over the past year we have collectively logged thousands of hours of work time on the ranges which have resulted in some very real improvements to our ranges and facilities. To list the major ones - new 25 yard bullet deflector, re-built berms at 25 and 100 yds, new target posts at 25 yds, added soil over all lower ranges, gravel walkways to keep our feet drier, action range earth work, action range privacy fence, toilet building DONE!, and a bunch of grass cutting, trimming and road cleanup. Not to mention, we had some mighty fine lunches along the way – thanks to all the cooks! Overall, we have accomplished a lot, especially for an all volunteer workforce. So a hearty "job well done" from the EC to everyone who helped. To those that didn't help, please consider turning out next year to do your part.

<u>Action Range Status</u>: Persistent rain has delayed re-grading of ranges and addition of gravel. As things dry up, we will have some adhoc work parties during Jan/Feb to pour and finish concrete slabs and pre-fab trusses for roofs of covered firing areas. We will also need to trench for conduit for future power. So – buy some thermals and be on the lookout for emails during Jan/Feb announcing adhoc work parties.

2012 Shooting Event Schedule: Anyone wishing to schedule shooting events during 2012, please contact me with details. I will integrate into calendar on first come, first serve basis. Keep in mind that we already have the 2nd Saturday booked for IPSC, the 3rd Saturday for work parties, the 4th Saturday for benchrest, and the 4th Sunday for Cowboy Action. The rest is wide open – so get me your inputs as soon as you know what you want to do.

2012 Work Party Projects: Looking ahead to 2012, here are the major projects we plan to undertake:

- 1. Action ranges complete earthwork, gravel, power conduit, covered firing areas and open up for business.
- 2. Re-build 25 yd covered firing area on lower ranges, new cover and concrete slab
- 3. Complete concrete slab along 200 yd firing line.
- 4. Re-gravel road

Range Safety Notes

WITH HUNTING SEASON OPEN, HUNTERS SHOULD BE AWARE OF WHERE THEY ARE ON THE PROPERTY IN RELATION TO THE RANGES.

<u>Please stay off the line during a "CEASE FIRE"</u>, some folks are still remaining on the line while others are down range, rules are explained below. During work parties all ranges are closed, all fire arms are to remain in your vehicle until after the monthly meeting.

I would like to remind everyone to please take the time to go over the range rules below with guests that you might bring to the range before engaging in actual shooting.

During casual shooting always appoint someone as Range Safety Officer (RSO); if you are the first person on the range, you are it. When you leave the range, turn RSO duties over to someone else. EVERYONE keep in mind, when a "CEASE FIRE" is called, unload your weapon, lay the weapon on the bench with the action open and step away from the line, NO ONE is to touch anything on the firing line until the range is "HOT". KEEP THE MUZZLE DOWN RANGE AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON THE LINE. WHEN MOVING TO AND FROM YOUR VEHICLE OR A DIFFERENT FIRING POSITION WITH AN UNCASED WEAPON, KEEP THE WEAPON UNLOADED, WITH THE ACTION OPEN, MUZZLE POINTED AT THE GROUND, FINGER OFF OF THE TRIGGER.

Target frames are to be used for holding target backers, not clay pigeons, cans plastic bottles, balloons etc. Staple balloons to target backers if you shoot balloons, hang plastic bottles, etc. with a string from a cross member. DO NOT lean anything against an upright to shoot at, build your own frame and set up in front of a berm, be sure that your rounds impact the berm. No cross firing on the ranges, shoot at the target directly in front of you, do not shoot into the ground or into standing water.

TAKE YOUR TRASH WITH YOU WHEN YOU LEAVE.

If you remove stools or benches from under the covered part of the line please put them back when finished. Someone put time and effort into building this equipment for the club, **YOUR CLUB**, so take care of **YOUR** stuff.

If you see anyone deliberately destroying club property, report the person or persons to any one of the Executive Committee or any member of the Facility Board.

Remember, there are extra gate locks in the ammo can located in the lower left compartment the target shed on the lower ranges.
